

RESOLUTION

INTRODUCED BY: Dan Rubin

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE MUNICIPAL LIBRARY DISTRICT OF MAPLEWOOD, MISSOURI, That the rate of taxation for the year 2022 is hereby fixed at

GENERAL FUND

2.01 mills on each \$1.00, or twenty and one-tenths cents (.201) on each \$100.00 of the assessed valuation of all residential property made taxable by Law within the limits of the Municipal Library District of Maplewood for the General Fund for the maintenance of a free public library,

2.87 mills on each \$1.00, or twenty-eight and seven-tenths cents (.287) on each \$100.00 of the assessed valuation of all commercial property made taxable by Law within the limits of the Municipal Library District of Maplewood for the General Fund for the maintenance of a free public library,

3.02 mills on each \$1.00, or thirty and two-tenths cents (.302) on each \$100.00 of the assessed valuation of all personal property made taxable by Law within the limits of the Municipal Library District of Maplewood for the General Fund for the maintenance of a free public library,

DEBT SERVICE

0.53 mills on each \$1.00, or five and three-tenths cents (.053) on each \$100.00 of the assessed valuation of all residential property made taxable by Law within the limits of the Municipal Library District of Maplewood for the Debt Service Fund of the library,

0.53 mills on each \$1.00, or five and three-tenths cents (.053) on each \$100.00 of the assessed valuation of all commercial property made taxable by Law within the limits of the Municipal Library District of Maplewood for the Debt Service Fund of the library,

0.53 mills on each \$1.00, or five and three-tenths cents (.053) on each \$100.00 of the assessed valuation of all personal property made taxable by Law within the limits of the Municipal Library District of Maplewood for the Debt Service Fund of the library,


If the tax rates allowed as determined by the State of Missouri are different than the proposed rates, the Library will set the rates at the rates determined by the State.
